## City of Ashland Burn Permit Regulations Ashland Volunteer Fire Department

## 1. You will receive a ticket if you do not follow all rules.

- 2. Burn must be attended by an adult until fire is completely out.
- 3. Burning not permitted if wind exceeds ten (10) miles per hour.
- 4. None of the following can be burned: garbage, salvage materials, asbestos debris, construction debris, petroleum products (tar products and tar paper, shingles, asphaltic siding, etc.), chemicals, or chemical/pesticide containers.
- 5. No road ditches may be burned.
- 6. Permittee must have capability of extinguishment available: water, hose, or extinguisher.
- 7. Ground cover must have perimeter around it cleared of combustibles.
- 8. Burning may not create a nuisance to people in neighboring residences, businesses, or recreational areas, and the smoke of any burning may not obscure any public roadway.
- 9. No burning in City limits. Materials must be removed to burn site.
- 10. Certain burning must be done with a permit issued from the State of Nebraska Environmental Control and a special permit will be required if burning in Lancaster County.
- 11. This permit does not allow any industrial or commercial burning.
- 12. No burning within twenty-five (25) feet of any building, and this permit does not allow burning of buildings or structures (for which a special permit is required).
- 13. Fire must be extinguished one (1) hour before sunset. (Liquid petroleum products may not be used to accelerate or sustain the fire).
