#### ORDINANCE 1166

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE FOLLOWING PORTIONS OF THE ZONING ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND: SECTION 2.03 AND SUBSECTIONS B & C OF SECTIONS 5.12, 5.14, 5.15, AND 5.16 OF THE ZONING ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, AS PROVIDED IN THE CITY OF ASHLAND MUNICIPAL ZONING ORDINANCE; TO PROVIDE FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF; TO ORDER THE PUBLICATION OF THE ORDINANCE IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, SAUNDERS COUNTY, NEBRASKA, THAT THE CITY'S ZONING ORDINANCES BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

#### **SECTION 1:**

That Subsection B, <u>Permitted Uses</u>, of Section 5.12, <u>B-1 General Business District</u> be amended to read:

- 1. Retail establishments as defined in Article 2, carried on within an enclosed building
- 2. Business services as defined in Article 2
- 3. Clothing and apparel shops as defined in Article 2
- 4. Cleaning establishments such as laundromats, dry cleaning, and laundries, laundry pickup and delivery stations
- 5. Small equipment sales and services as defined in Article 2
- 6. Personal services as defined in Article 2
- 7. Food service such as eating and drinking establishments
- 8. Motels, hotels
- 9. Civic and cultural facilities including auditoriums, civic centers, fire stations, and other safety services facilities
- 10. Professional services as defined in Article 2
- 11. Public overhead and underground local distribution utilities
- 12. Mortuaries, funeral homes, and funeral chapels
- 13. Transportation depots such as railroad passenger station, bus station
- 14. Cocktail lounges, taverns, and retail liquor stores
- 15. Child care center

That Subsection C, <u>Permitted Conditional Uses</u>, of Section 5.12, <u>B-1 General Business</u> <u>District</u> be amended to read:

- 1. Lumber yards, hardware stores, and building material sales yards with enclosed and screened storage areas
- 2. Bowling alley, drive-in restaurant, drive-in theater, and other similar place of entertainment or amusement when located at least one hundred (100) feet away from any R District boundary
- 3. Automobile display, sales, service, and repair
- 4. Satellite dish antennas conforming with the supplemental regulations of this Ordinance
- 5. Outdoor storage containers, limited to two containers per business and subject to the supplemental regulations of Article 8
- 6. Living quarters used by watchmen or custodians of the commercially used property
- 7. Community centers and clubs providing meeting, recreational, or social facilities for private/nonprofit/noncommercial associations
- 8. Offices/headquarters for trades such as plumbers and electricians, when such uses are consistent with a commercial district.
- 9. Retail farm implements, equipment, supplies, and feed

- 3. Clothing and apparel shops as defined in Article 2
- 4. Cleaning establishments such as laundromats, dry cleaning, and laundries, laundry pickup and delivery stations

- 5. Small equipment sales and services as defined in Article 2
- 6. Personal services as defined in Article 2
- 7. Food service such as eating and drinking establishments
- 8. Motels, hotels
- 9. Civic and cultural facilities including auditoriums, civic centers, fire stations, and other safety services facilities

- 2. Satellite dish antennas conforming with the supplemental regulations of this Ordinance
- 3. Outdoor storage containers, limited to two containers per business and subject to the supplemental regulations of Article 8
- 4. Living quarters used by watchmen or custodians of the commercially used property
- 5. Community centers and clubs providing meeting, recreational, or social facilities for private/nonprofit/noncommercial associations
- 6. Offices/headquarters for trades such as plumbers and electricians, when such uses are consistent with a commercial district.

- 3. Clothing and apparel shops as defined in Article 2
- 4. Cleaning establishments such as laundromats, dry cleaning, and laundries, laundry pickup and delivery stations
- 5. Small equipment sales and services as defined in Article 2
- 6. Personal services as defined in Article 2
- 7. Food service such as eating and drinking establishments
- 8. Motels, hotels
- 9. Public overhead and underground local distribution utilities
- 10. Transportation depots such as railroad passenger station, bus station
- 11. Cocktail lounges, taverns, and retail liquor stores
- 12. Agriculture on more than ten (10) acres
- 13. Lumber yards, hardware stores, and building material sales yards with enclosed and screened storage areas

#### SECTION 4:

That Subsection B, <u>Permitted Uses</u>, of Section 5.16, <u>I-1 Light Industrial District</u> be amended to read:

- 1. Public overhead and underground local distribution utilities
- 2. Agricultural farms, truck gardens, greenhouses, plant nurseries, orchards, storage facilities for grain and other farm and agricultural products, and the usual agricultural farm buildings and structures
- 3. Lumber yards, hardware stores, and building material sales yards with enclosed and screened storage areas
- 4. Veterinarian or animal hospital, provided any such building, kennel, or exercise runway is located at least one hundred (100) feet away from any R District boundary
- 5. Adult Establishments, subject to the supplemental regulations in Article 8
- 6. Automobile display, sales, service, and repair
- 7. Licensed/Unlicensed recreational vehicle storage, outdoors with fence/screening and/or within an enclosed building
- 8. Assembly, fabrication, and processing of products inside an enclosed building, except hazardous or combustible materials
- 9. Laboratories
- 10. Highway maintenance yards or buildings
- 11. Self-storage units
- 12. Printing and publishing businesses
- 13. Manufacture and assembly of electrical and electronic appliances
- 14. Manufacturing, compounding, processing, packaging, or treatment of articles or merchandise from previously prepared materials
- 15. Machine shops and manufacturing of light sheet metal products including heating and ventilation equipment
- 16. Stone and monument works
- 17. Fuel storage yards
- 18. Fixed plants for processing stone, gravel, or clay

- 19. Distribution centers
- 20. Warehouses and wholesale businesses

# That Subsection C, <u>Permitted Conditional Uses</u>, of Section 5.16, <u>I-1 Light Industrial District</u> be amended to read:

- 1. Satellite dish antennas conforming with the supplemental regulations of this Ordinance
- 2. Outdoor storage containers, not limited in quantity but subject to the supplemental regulations of Article 8
- 3. Offices/headquarters for trades such as plumbers and electricians, when such uses are consistent with a commercial district.
- 4. Utility substations and communications
- 5. Carting, express, and hauling truck terminals
- 6. Storage of fireworks
- 7. Manufacturing of concrete products
- 8. Manufacturing, display, and sales of farm and industrial equipment
- 9. Offices/headquarters for trucking companies
- 10. Truck terminals including truck washing facilities
- 11. Heavy truck or trailer sales, display, service, or repair
- 12. Fertilizer storage or processing
- 13. Acetylene gas manufacturing or storage
- 14. Small wind energy systems
- 15. Mining excavation, sand quarries, and other forms of extraction
- 16. Radio, television, and communication towers and transmitters
- 17. Auction houses that warehouse sale items and sell said items within and/or outside of the auction facility, but on the premises
- 18. Manufacturing of oil, rubber, or leather goods
- 19. Manufacturing, fabrication, and treatment of lumber or wood products
- 20. Manufacturing of cement, lime, gypsum, or plaster-of-paris
- 21. Manufacturing of bakery products
- 22. Feed and forage plants
- 23. Manufacturing of grain mill products
- 24. Manufacturing of meat products

## **SECTION 5:**

That Section 2.03, <u>Definitions</u> be amended to add:

"Small Equipment shall mean pieces of equipment, appliances, and hand tools which typically require electricity, gas, or steam to operate, such as radios, televisions, business machines, musical instruments, sewing machines, vacuums, microwave ovens, and plumbing/heating/electrical fixtures."

"Personal Services shall mean establishments primarily engaged in rendering services to individuals such as barber shops, beauty salons, weight-loss, photographic studios, and tattoo parlors."

"Business Services shall mean establishments primarily engaged in rendering services to individuals and businesses, such as advertising, banking and finance, insurance, real estate, offices, postal stations, printing, credit services, security brokers and exchange, title abstracting, investment services, data processing, and computer programming."

"Apparel Shop shall mean retail stores where clothing is sold and serviced, such as department stores, shoe stores, dress shops, hosiery and millinery shops, shoe repair, tailors, and alterations."

### SECTION 6: REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT

That all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

### SECTION 7: WHEN OPERATIVE

That this ordinance shall take effect after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form according to law.
